The Lenten Season begins on Ash Wednesday February 26, 2020

<u>Masses:</u> 6:00 am, 8:00 am 9:30 am – School Mass 7:00 pm (No Novena)

Ash Wednesday is a day of **fasting and abstinence. Fasting** (one full meal and 2 small meals, no snacking) applies to those 18-60 years and does not apply to those who are pregnant, sick or elderly. **Abstinence** from meat applies to those 13 years and older. During Lent, the faithful prepare for Easter through Prayer, Penance and Works of Charity or Mercy. Ashes will be distributed at all masses.
