<u>Reflection</u> 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Be not Afraid

"Do not be afraid!" These words from Jesus in today's Gospel should be a source of reassurance for all of His stewards. These same words were echoed by St. John Paul II at his inaugural homily as Pope. He said, "Brothers and sisters, do not be afraid to welcome Christ and accept his power. Help the Pope and all those who wish to serve Christ and with Christ's power to serve the human person and the whole of mankind. Do not be afraid. Open wide the doors for Christ."

As stewards of Christ, it is easy to succumb to various fears. The fear of financial burdens, family crises, health complications as well as the spiritual fear of not being a "good" enough disciple. It is to these fears and more that Jesus, and St. John Paul II, says to be not afraid.

But how do we fight these temptations of fear? We fight them through prayer and trust in God. Whenever fears or worries take hold of our lives, whenever we doubt the fruits or importance of our stewardship, let us run to prayer. It is in those quiet moments before the Lord that He will slowly reveal His love for us which "casts out fear" (1 John 4:18). Let us take a moment today to intentionally pray to God, asking Him to fill us with greater trust in His goodness.

Mass Online Registration will update ONCE A WEEK.

All the faithful in the Archdiocese of Toronto remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday mass. Please note that every reasonable precaution has been and will continue to be taken by the Archdiocese of Toronto to protect your health and safety. However, there can be no guarantees of complete protection as there will always be risks of contracting viral infection through large gatherings. All those attending Mass do so at their own risk. It is important for families and individuals to take responsibility for protecting themselves and others.

PLEASE READ BEFORE REGISTERING FOR MASS:

1. Physical distancing is to be observed everywhere on the Church property (parking lot, entrance, foyer etc.), except for members of the same household.

2. ONE TICKET PER PERSON. If you have 4 members in your family including yourself, please register for 4 tickets. Anyone not registered for Mass <u>will not</u> be admitted. We must maintain this for everyone's safety. Also if you register for more than 1 mass on the same day, then all registrations after the 1st mass you have registered for <u>will be cancelled</u>.

3. Please plan to arrive early to allow for timely admittance for Mass. While you are waiting in line, please stay 6ft apart.

4. Pews are marked where you and/or your family may sit. Please comply with staff seating arrangements and/or instructions.

5. The entrance is through the main doors.

6. Kindly bring your own mask(s) and wear it at all times. **Masks are required for entry into the church**.

7. Further instructions will be provided during Mass.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this unprecedented time.

IMPORTANT: The following MUST stay home for the sake of the parish community:

Individuals with COVID-19 or live with someone with COVID-19.

Individuals who have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 2 weeks or to someone with COVID-19.

Individuals who are ill, even with the slightest symptoms, especially fever, dry cough, shortness of breath and flu-like symptoms.

Those who have recently traveled outside of Canada.
