Dear BT Parishioners,

By now, you all have probably heard that I will be leaving the parish as of July 23. My next assignment for the diocese is to become a licensed clinical psychologist. I will begin

doctoral studies in mid-August at the Institute for the Psychological Sciences at Divine Mercy University in Sterling, Virginia, all the while living at a parish in the Diocese of Arlington.

Many have asked whether I really must leave, especially at this time and under these circumstances. Virginia, like Ontario, has seen a decline in cases for the last 2 months and the governor has also given permission for classes to resume in-person for the fall. Masks in public have been mandatory since the end of May, so all precautions are being taken. Additionally, I will also be extra careful. I am truly grateful for everyone's concern for my safety

It is unfortunate that we can't have any sort of farewell gathering at this time. I have thoroughly enjoyed my ministry at BT and I am most grateful to Fr. Ed, the staff, the pastoral team, and all the parishioners for the wonderful welcome and generosity extended to me. My 2 years at the parish have flown by; it feels like only yesterday that I moved in, yet I have also got to know many of you well.

My program is a fairly rigorous one with very little time off. The longest break I get is at Christmas and I hope to return this Christmas to properly say goodbye. I shall continue to pray for you all and I also ask for your prayers.

PLEASE READ BEFORE REGISTERING FOR MASS:

1. Physical distancing is to be observed everywhere on the Church property (parking lot, entrance, foyer etc.), except for members of the same household.

2. ONE TICKET PER PERSON.

If you have 4 members in your family including yourself, please register for 4 tickets.

Eventbrite lists all events on every page for everyday. If you are ordering for Saturday at 4:30pm please make sure the title on the page says Saturday 4:30pm and scroll down to the Saturday 4:30pm order box to place your order.

Anyone not registered for Mass <u>will not</u> be admitted. We must maintain this for everyone's safety. If you register for more than 1 mass on the same day, then all registrations after the 1st mass you have registered for <u>will be cancelled</u>.

3. **PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY** to allow for timely admittance for Mass. While you are waiting in line, please stay 6ft apart. ONCE MASS STARTS THE DOORS WILL BE CLOSED AND LOCKED, NO ADMITTANCE IS POSSIBLE ONCE THE DOORS ARE CLOSED - thank you for your understanding.

4. Pews are marked where you and/or your family may sit. Please comply with staff seating arrangements and/or instructions.

5. The entrance is through the main doors.

6. Kindly bring your own mask(s) and wear it at all times. **Masks are required for entry into the church**.

7. Further instructions will be provided during Mass.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this unprecedented time.
