Please do not leave your items the weekend before November 14-15 and after the truck has gone. We have no way to deliver the items to their proper destination.

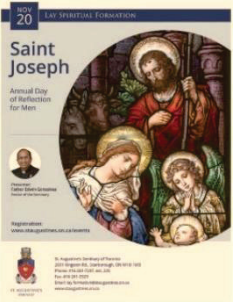


**Moms' Group Meeting
